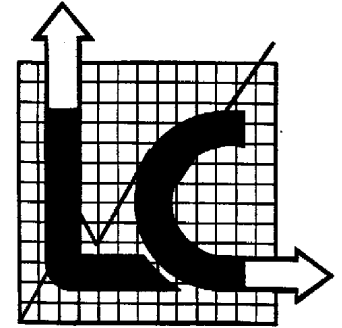

Law Enforcement -

Ride along for an evening with a law enforcement officer. Visit with a judge, attorneys, and tour the jail.

Quality of Life –

Hear from community leaders regarding future community planning and hear from various organizations that help address community needs.

Government -

Travel to Lincoln, sit in on a legislative session

and visit the Governor, a Supreme Court judge and Legislative Senators.

City Government- Discuss current issues of our community with the Mayor and City Council.

Graduation-Develop a class project that will make a difference in Columbus.
